The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of April are listed below in bold. The previous month is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is noon, **Thursday, April 27, 2017**. If your student has said his/her Scripture by then, he/she will receive a treat.

The Kindergarten Scripture for April is:

Galatians 5:16 (NLT)

Verse 16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves.

Ephesians 3:16 (NLT)

Verse 16 I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit.

The Grades 1 & 2 Scripture for April is:

Galatians 5:16-17a (NLT)

Verse 16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves.

Verse 17a The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants.

Ephesians 3:17 (NLT)

Verse 17 Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.

The Grade 3 Scripture for April is:

Galatians 5:16 & 18 (NLT)

Verse 16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves.

Verse 18 But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.

Ephesians 3:16-18 (NLT)

Verse 16 I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit.

Verse 17 Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.
