The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of April are listed below in bold. The previous months' scripture is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon**, **Thursday**, **April 26**, **2018**. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The Kindergarten Scripture for April is:

<u>James 3:18 (NLT)</u>

Verse 18 And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

Colossians 3:16 a (NLT)

Verse 16a Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives.

The Grade 1 Scripture for April is:

Colossians 3:14-15a (NLT)

Verse 14 Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. Verse 15a And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts.

The Grade 2 Scripture for April is:

James 3:17 (NLT)

Verse 17 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere.

Colossians 3:14-15 (NLT)

The Grades 3 – 12 Scripture for April is:
