### The Kindergarten Scripture for February is:

#### Ephesians 2:21-22 (NASB)

**Verse 21** in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord,

**Verse 22** in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

#### Romans 8:5-8 (NLT)

**Verse 7** For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will.

**Verse 8** That's why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God.

### The Grades 1 & 2 Scripture for February is:

#### Ephesians 2:19 (NASB)

**Verse 19** So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,

#### Romans 8:5 (NLT)

**Verse 5** Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit.

### The Grade 3 Scripture for February is:
