Dear Parents:

The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of January are listed below in bold. The previous months' scripture is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon**, **Thursday**, **January 25**, **2017**. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat. *Please note: There is no scripture memory for High School students this month due to limited school days and High School exams.*

The Kindergarten Scripture for January is:

1 Peter 2:17 (NLT)

Verse 17 Respect everyone, and love the family of believers. Fear God, and respect the king.

Matthew 5:48 (NLT)

Verse 48 But you are to be perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect.

The Grade 1 Scripture for January is:

1 Peter 2:13a & 17 (NLT)

- Verse 13a For the Lord's sake, submit to all human authority
- Verse 17 Respect everyone, and love the family of believers. Fear God, and respect the king.

Matthew 5:43 - 44 (NLT)

- Verse 43 "You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.
