The Kindergarten Scripture for March is:

Ephesians 3:16 (NLT)

Verse 16 I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit.

Ephesians 2:21-22 (NASB)

Verse 21 in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord,

Verse 22 in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

The Grades 1 & 2 Scripture for March is:

Ephesians 3:17 & 19a (NLT)

Verse 17 Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.

Verse 19a May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully.

Ephesians 2:19 (NASB)

The Grade 3 Scripture for March is:
