The Kindergarten Scripture for March is:

Colossians 3:16 a (NLT)

Verse 16a Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives.

1Thessalonians 5:11 & 17 (NLT)

Verse 11 So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing.

Verse 17 Never stop praying.

The Grade 1 Scripture for March is:

Colossians 3:14-15a (NLT)

Verse 14 Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony.

Verse 15a And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts.

1Thessalonians 5:11 & 16-17 (NLT)
