- The Grade 12 Graduation Ceremony will be held on **Thursday, June 27th** at 4:00 in the afternoon

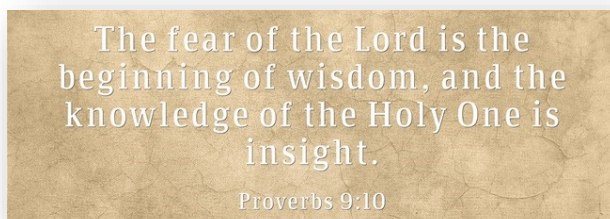
SCRIPTURE PLAQUES
