The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of May are listed below in bold. The previous month is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is noon, **Thursday, May 18, 2017**. If your student has said his/her Scripture by then, he/she will receive a treat.

The Kindergarten Scripture for May is:

Galatians 5:22-25 (NLT)

The Grades 1 & 2 Scripture for May is:
