The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of May are listed below in bold. The previous months' scripture memory is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, May 17, 2018**. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The Kindergarten Scripture for May is:

Psalm 96:12 (NLT)

Verse 12 Let the fields and their crops burst out with joy! Let the trees of the forest sing for joy

James 3:18 (NLT)

Verse 18 And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

The Grade 1 Scripture for May is:

Psalm 29:1-2 (NLT)

Verse 1 Honor the Lord, you heavenly beings; honor the Lord for his glory and strength.
Verse 2 Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

James 3:18 (NLT)

Verse 18 And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

The Grade 2 Scripture for May is:

Psalm 29:1-2 (NLT)

Verse 1 Honor the Lord, you heavenly beings; honor the Lord for his glory and strength.
Verse 2 Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

James 3:17 (NLT)

Verse 17 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere.

The Grades 3 Scripture for May is:

Psalm 96:12 (NLT)

Verse 12 Let the fields and their crops burst out with joy! Let the trees of the forest sing for joy

Psalm 29:1-2 (NLT)

Verse 1 Honor the Lord, you heavenly beings; honor the Lord for his glory and strength.

Verse 2 Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

The Grades 4 – 12 Scripture for May is:

Psalm 96:12-13 (NLT)

Verse 13 before the Lord, for he is coming! He is coming to judge the earth. He will judge the world with justice, and the nations with his truth.

Psalm 29:1-2 (NLT)

Verse 1 Honor the Lord, you heavenly beings; honor the Lord for his glory and strength.

Verse 2 Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.

James 3:16-18 (NLT)

Verse 16 For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind.

Verse 17 But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere.

Verse 18 And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.
