The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of April are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, April 27, 2023**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for April is:

Psalm 97:11-12 (NLT)

Verse 11 Light shines on the godly, and joy on those whose hearts are right.
Verse 12 May all who are godly rejoice in the LORD and praise his holy name!

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for April is:

Romans 15:5-6, 13-14 (NIV)

- Verse 5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had,
Verse 6 so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.
Verse 13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
Verse 14 I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge and competent to instruct one another.

Psalm 126:1-6 (NLT)

- Verse 1 When the LORD brought back his exiles to Jerusalem, it was like a dream!
Verse 2 We were filled with laughter, and we sang for joy. And the other nations said, "What amazing things the LORD has done for them."
Verse 3 Yes, the LORD has done amazing things for us! What joy!
Verse 4 Restore our fortunes, LORD, as streams renew the desert.
Verse 5 Those who plant in tears will harvest with shouts of joy.
Verse 6 They weep as they go to plant their seed, but they sing as they return with the harvest.
