The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of December are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, December 27, 2022**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for December is:

Psalm 145:3 (NIV)

Verse 3 Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; his greatness no one can fathom.

Romans 15:13 (NIV)

Verse 13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The GRADES 1/2 Scripture for December is:

Psalm 145:3 & 7 (NIV)

Verse 3 Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; his greatness no one can fathom.

Verse 7 They celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness.

Romans 15:5-6 (NIV)

Verse 5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had,

Verse 6 so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The GRADE 3 Scripture for December is:

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for December is:

Romans 5:2-5 (NIV)

- Verse 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.
- Verse 3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- Verse 4 perseverance, character; and character, hope.
- Verse 5 And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.
