The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of February are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, February 16, 2023**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for February is:

Psalm 4:8 (NLT)

Verse 8 In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, O LORD, will keep me safe.

Psalm 118:24 (NLT)

Verse 24 This is the day the LORD has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it.

The GRADES 1/2 Scripture for February is:

Psalm 4:4 & 8 (NLT)

Verse 4 Don't sin by letting anger control you. Think about it overnight and remain silent.

Verse 8 In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, O LORD, will keep me safe.

Psalm 118:24 & 29 (NLT)

Verse 24 This is the day the LORD has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it.

Verse 29 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever.

The GRADE 3 Scripture for February is:

Psalm 4:4, 7-8 (NLT)

Verse 26 Bless the one who comes in the name of the LORD. We bless you from the house of the LORD.

Verse 29 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever.

The GRADES 5 – 8 Scripture for February is:

Psalm 4:4-8 (NLT)

Psalm 118:24-29 (NLT)

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for February is:

Psalm 16:1-2, 7-9, 11 (NLT)

- Verse 1 Keep me safe, O God, for I have come to you for refuge.
Verse 2 I said to the LORD, "You are my Master! Every good thing I have comes from you."
Verse 7 I will bless the LORD who guides me; even at night my heart instructs me.
Verse 8 I know the LORD is always with me. I will not be shaken, for he is right beside me.
Verse 9 No wonder my heart is glad, and I rejoice. My body rests in safety.
Verse 11 You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever.
