- ♦ What areas do you think you need to grow and focus on?
- ♦ Do you want me to ask the teacher any specific questions?

We are excited to be offering another group of Chapel Blocks. These have been of great value to our High School students. The dates our next set will run are March 4, 11, 18, 26

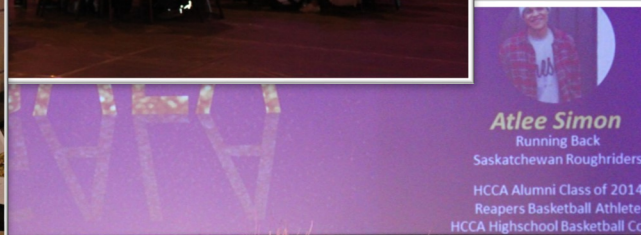
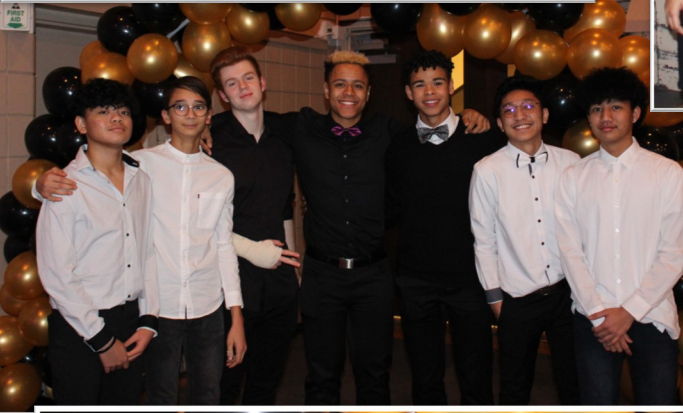
ATHLETICS GALA
