The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for March is:

Psalm 145:13 (NLT)

Verse 13 For your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. You rule throughout all generations. The LORD always keeps his promises; he is gracious in all he does

Romans 6:12-14 (NLT)

Sin is no longer your master, for you no longer live under the requirements of the law. In-Verse 14 stead, you live under the freedom of God's grace.

The GRADES 1 & 2 Scripture for March is:

Psalm 145:9 & 13 (NLT)

The High School Scripture for March is:

1 Peter 5:6-10 (NLT)

- Verse 8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.
- Verse 9 Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith. Remember that your family of believers all over the world is going through the same kind of suffering you are.
- Verse 10 In his kindness God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So after you have suffered a little while, he will restore, support, and strengthen you, and he will place you on a firm foundation.

Ephesians 2:4-5, 8-10 (NIV)

- Verse 4 ...because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy,
- Verse 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.
- Verse 8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—
- Verse 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.
- Verse 10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
