The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of May are listed below in bold. The Bible Club cut-off is **noon, Thursday, May 23, 2024**. The previous month is listed underneath. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for May is:

Psalm 86:5-6 (NIV)

Verse 5      You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you.  
Verse 6      Hear my prayer, LORD; listen to my cry for mercy.

Romans 3:23-24 (NCV)

Verse 23     Everyone has sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard,  
Verse 24     and all need to be made right with God by his grace, which is a free gift. They need to be made free from sin through Jesus Christ.

The GRADES 1 & 2 Scripture for May is:

Psalm 86:4-6 (NIV)

Verse 4      Bring joy to your servant, Lord, for I put my trust in you.

Verse 6      Hear my prayer, LORD; listen to my cry for mercy.

Romans 3:23-24 (NCV)

The High School Scripture for May is:

Hebrews 4:13-16 NIV

- Verse 13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.
- Verse 14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess.
- Verse 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.
- Verse 16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

2 Timothy 1:9-10 (NLT)

- Verse 9 For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus.
- Verse 10 And now he has made all of this plain to us by the appearing of Christ Jesus, our Savior. He broke the power of death and illuminated the way to life and immortality through the Good News.
