The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for May is:

The GRADES 9-12 Scripture for May is:

<u>James 1:1-5 & 12</u>

- Verse 2 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy.
- Verse 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.
- Verse 4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is full developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.
- Verse 5 If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking.
- Verse 12 God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

<u>Psalm 1:1-3</u>

- Verse 1 Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers.
- Verse 2 But they delight in the law of the LORD, meditating on it day and night.
- Verse 3 They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each seasons. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.
