The portions of Scripture that the students are required to learn for the month of November are listed below in bold. The previous months' scripture is listed underneath. The Bible Club cut-off is **Thursday, November 21, 2019**. All students in K-8 who recite their monthly scripture by this date will receive a bible club treat.

The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for November is:

Isaiah 43:2a

Verse 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned;
