The KINDERGARTEN Scripture for September is:

1 John 4:7 (NLT)

Verse 7 Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God.

The GRADES 1/2 Scripture for September is:

1 John 4:10-11 (NLT)

Verse 10 This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

The GRADE 3 Scripture for September is:

1 John 4:7-9 (NLT)
